



## Making a propagation mix

This mix can be used as a propagation medium or as a general potting mix.

Equipment: -garden sieve  
-60L bin with lid\*  
-wheelbarrow  
-bucket  
-compost spiral tool

Materials: -finished compost  
-Cocopeat brick/s  
-worm castings

### Ratio

compost : Cocopeat : worm castings 3 : 2 : 1 by volume

### Method

1. Sift out smaller particles of the compost into the wheelbarrow and use the unsifted material as mulch in the garden.
2. Transfer required volume of sifted compost to the bin.
3. Rehydrate Cocopeat according to direction on the packet.
4. When Cocopeat has fully expanded, add required volume to bin.
5. Add required volume of worm castings to the bin.
6. Using the compost spiral, thoroughly mix all materials together.

### Storage

Keep the mix in the bin with the lid on (to prevent it drying out) and store the bin in a cool sheltered place, out of direct sun.

#### \* Note

You don't necessarily have to do this mix in a 60L bin. The same result can be achieved in a bigger or smaller container as long as all materials are used according to ratio above.
